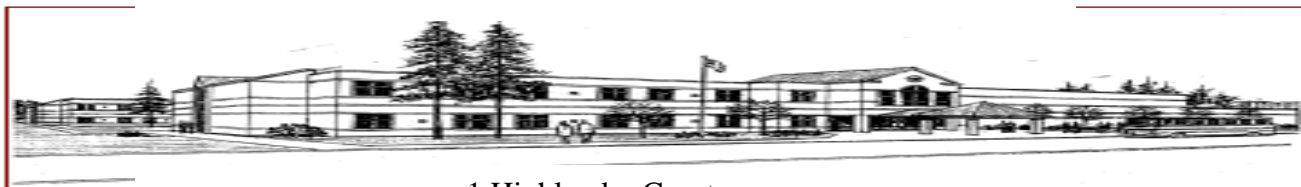

Dear Parents and Guardians of a Campbell High School Ninth Grade Student,

We hope you are enjoying this year's beautiful summer vacation. Welcome Freshman Day at Campbell High School is **Thursday, August 28, 2014**. This day is designed to support the smooth transition of our incoming ninth graders to their high school experience. Ninth graders will have an orientation program, including fun activities and a barbecue lunch. Transportation will be provided for all students. Ninth graders will arrive at Campbell High School by 9:00 am for an abbreviated school schedule to meet their teachers and administrators, learn about the co-curricular activities and programs. The day will end with a barbecue lunch with the staff. This program is only for ninth graders. On this day, freshmen will be dismissed at 1:15 pm. Please dress school appropriate for Welcome Freshman Day.

On this Welcome Freshman Day, each student's name along with their advisor's name and room number will be posted in the lobby by the front door. Students will pick up their first semester class schedule (with teacher names and room numbers) from their advisor. Students will follow an 8 period schedule to meet their teachers. Student Council representative are here to support all new students.

The Welcome Freshmen Day schedule for bus arrival at Campbell High School is between 8:45 am and 8:50 am. On this one day only, students will not be required to have a bus pass in order to be transported on a school bus. Busses will leave Campbell High School at 1:15 pm to return students to their bus stops.
